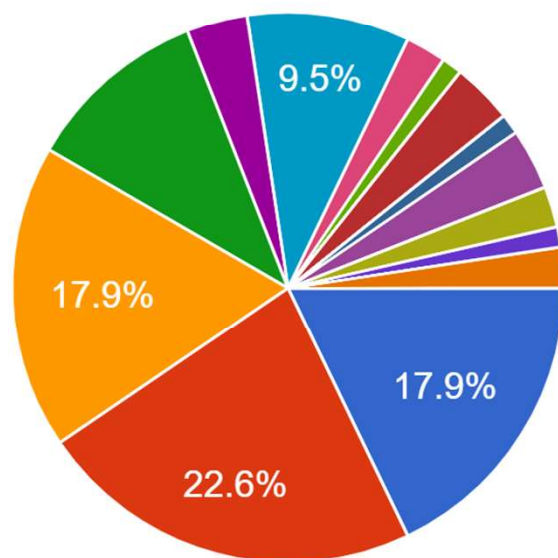

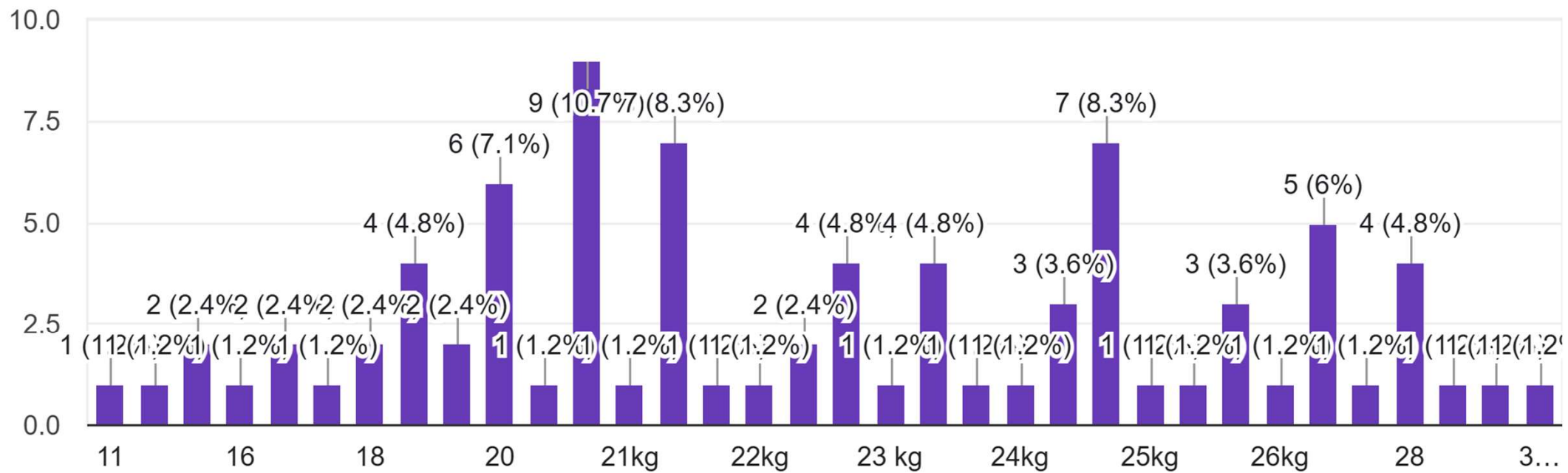

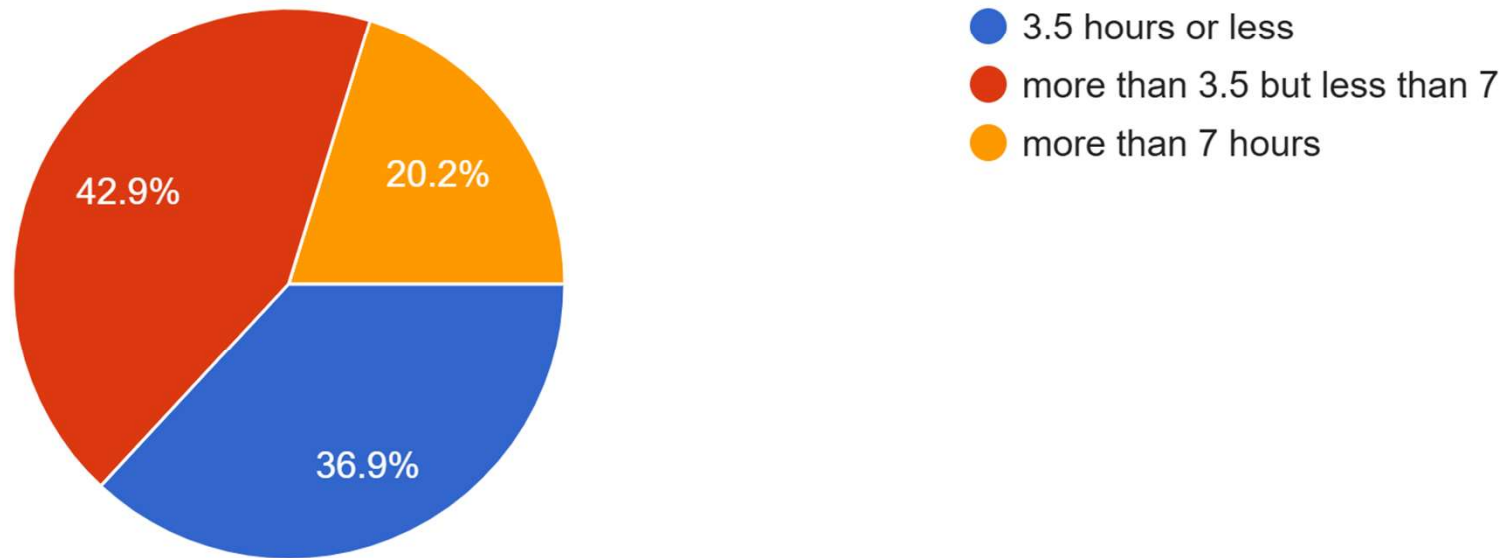

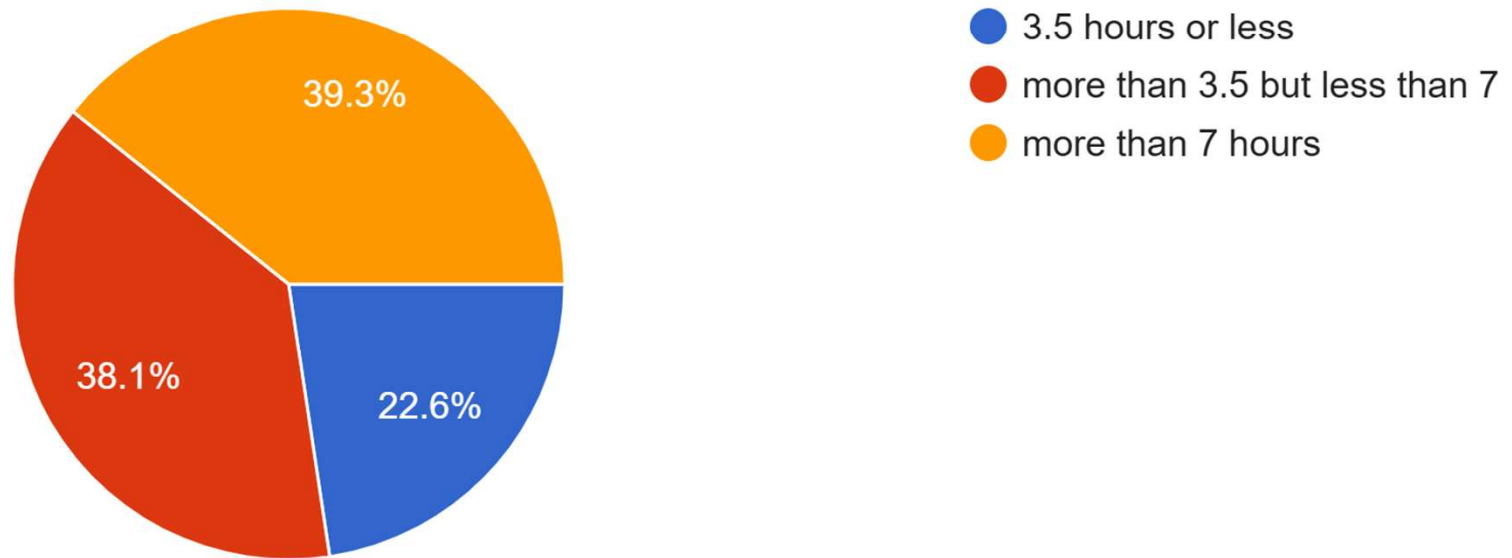
On an average week how much on-lead exercise does your dog get?

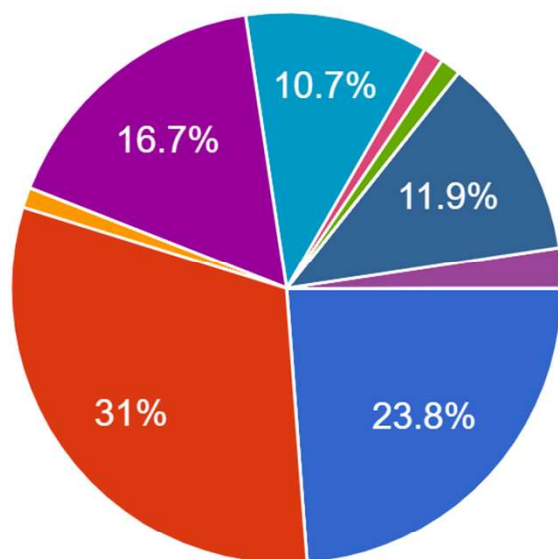

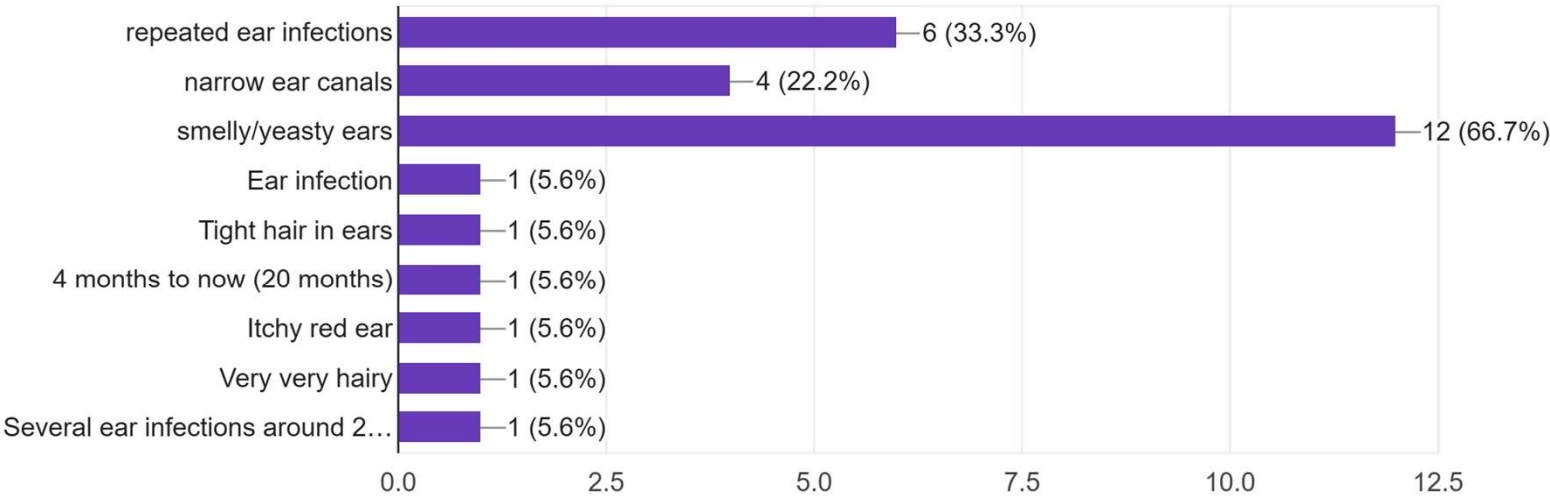

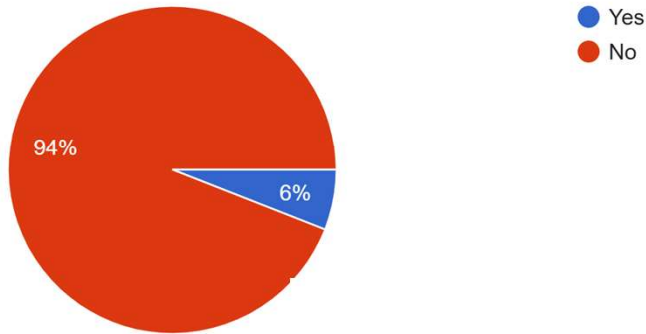

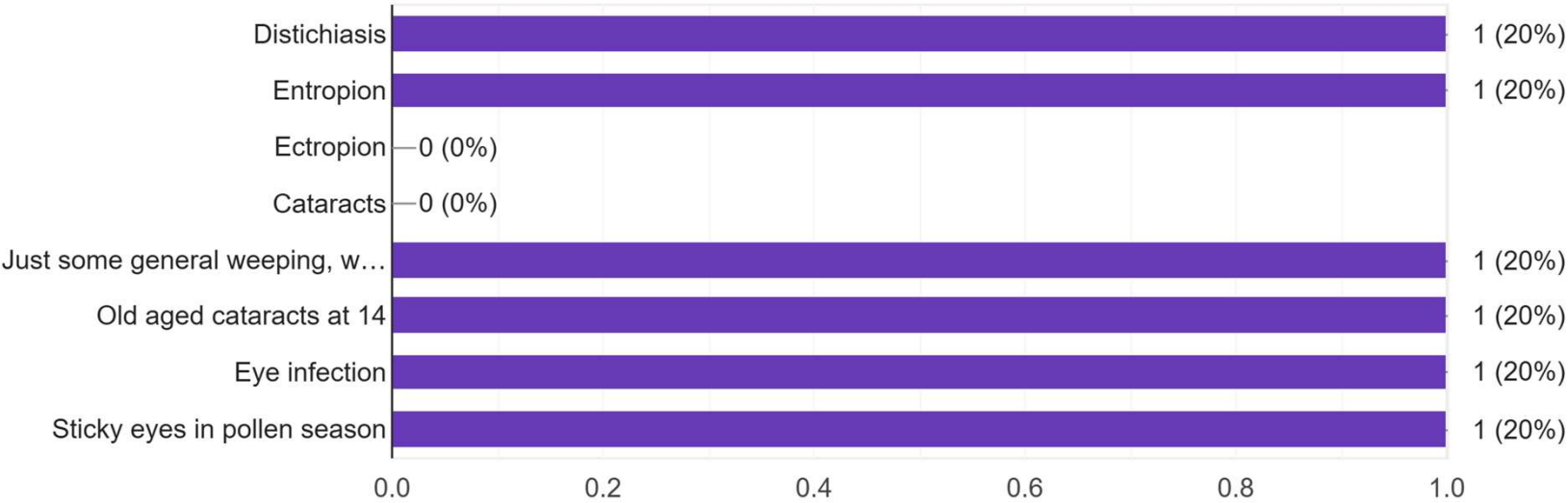

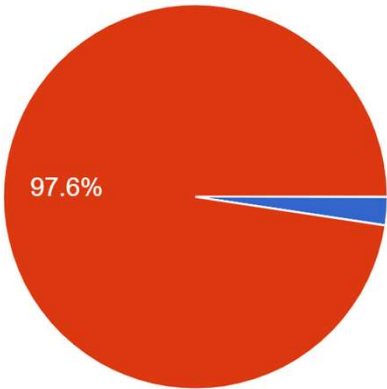

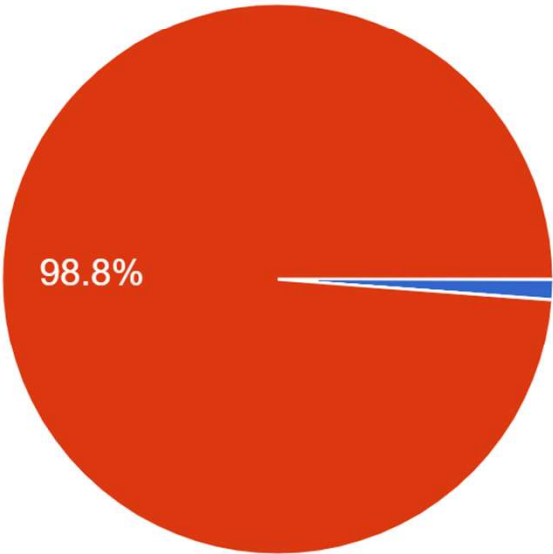

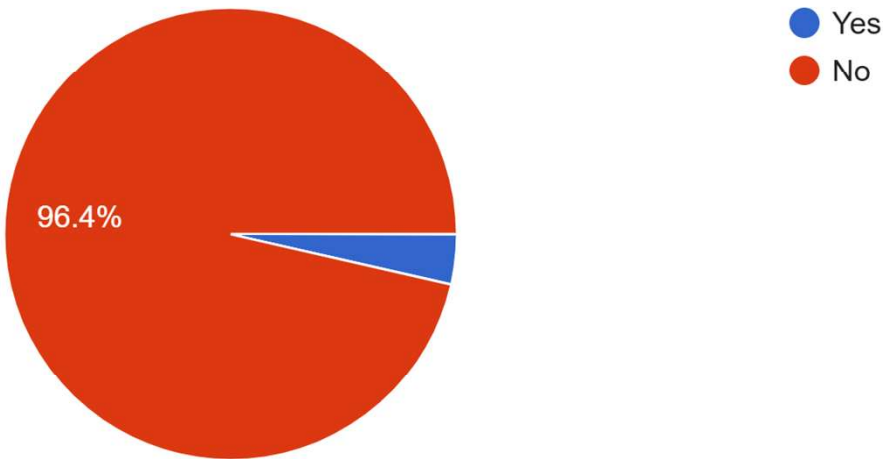

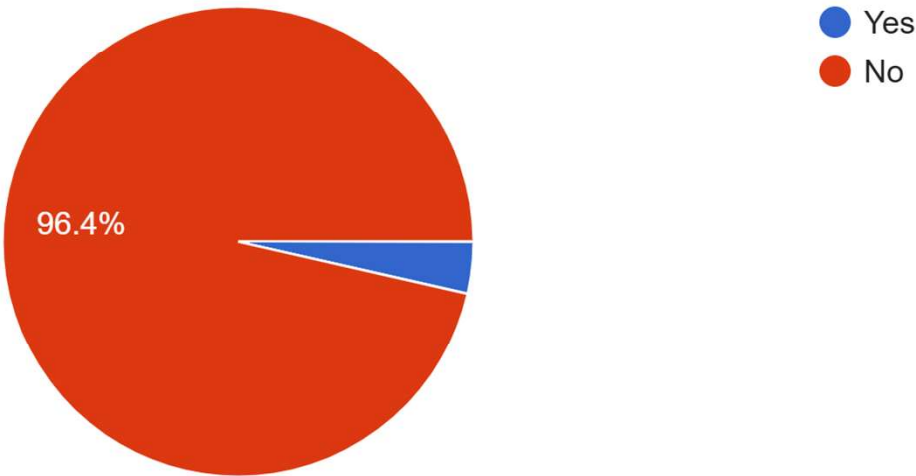

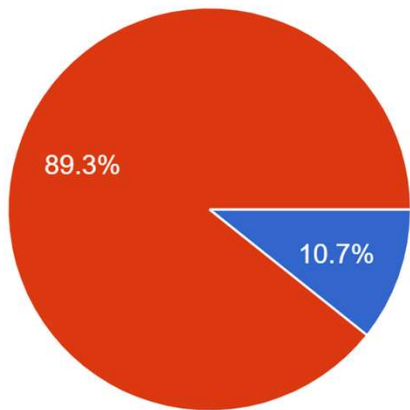

Two adult teeth on lower jaw did not grow at all - deciduous teeth were removed as roots had begun to reabsorb.

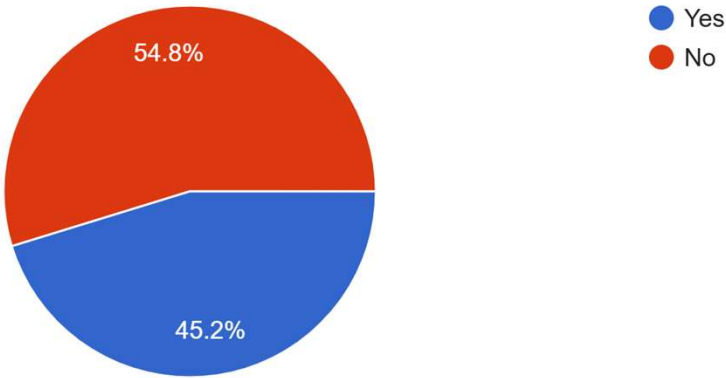

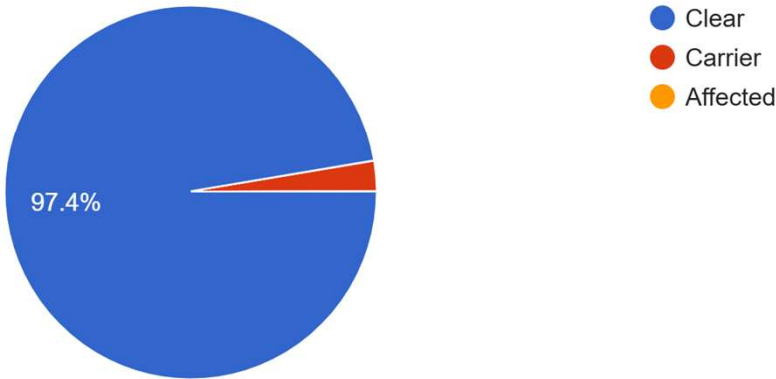
Is your dog DNA tested for Von Willebrand Type 1 disease ?

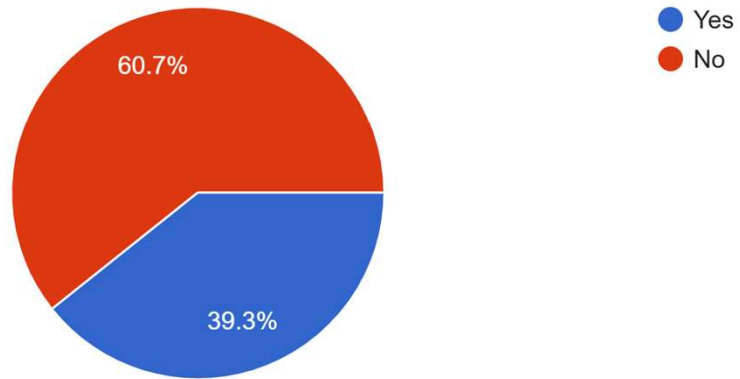

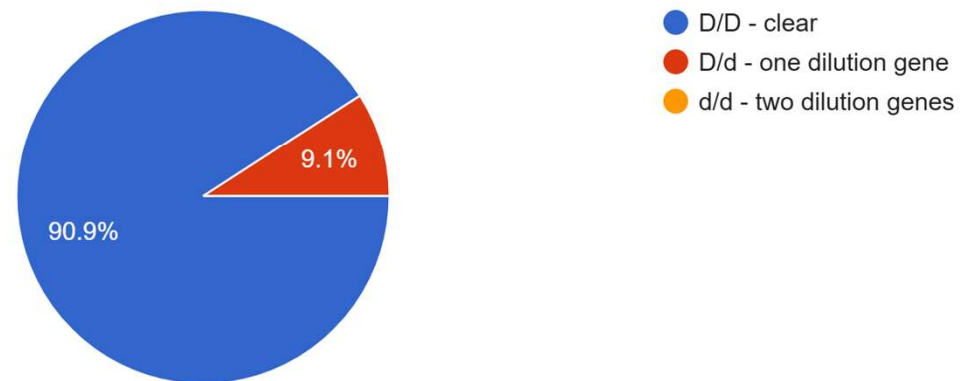
Is your dog DNA tested for D locus?

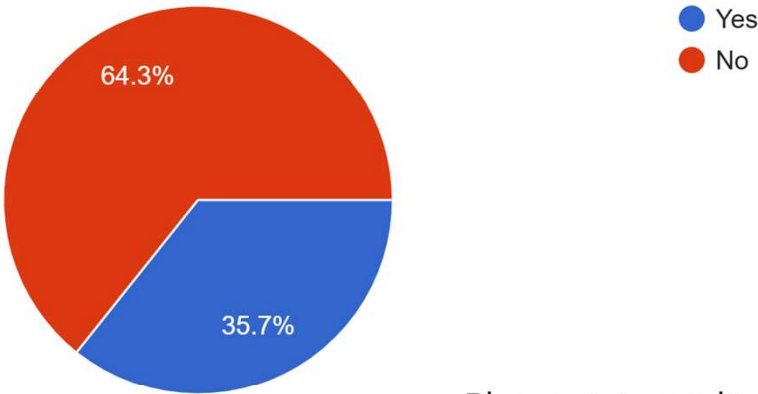

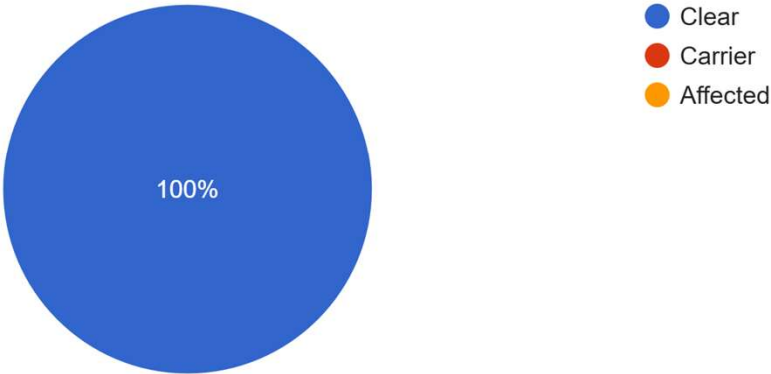

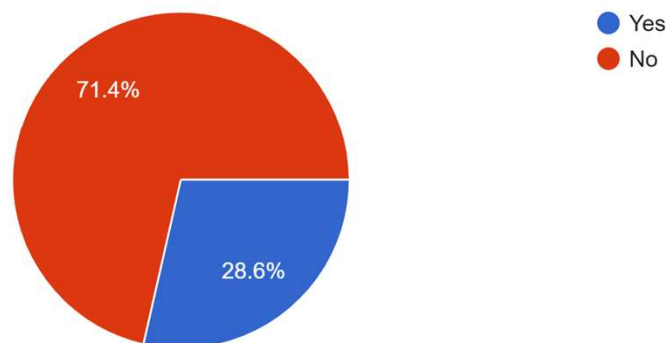

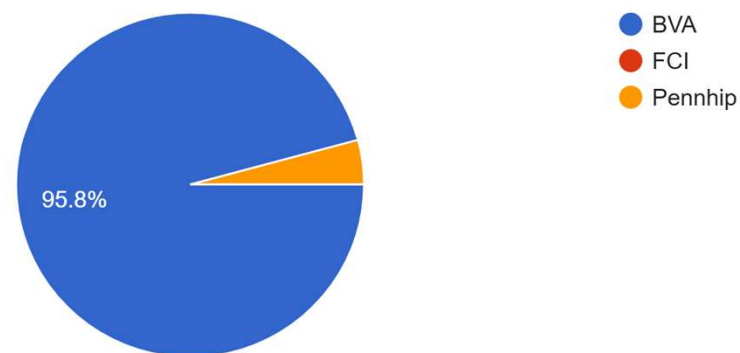
Has your dog been hip scored?

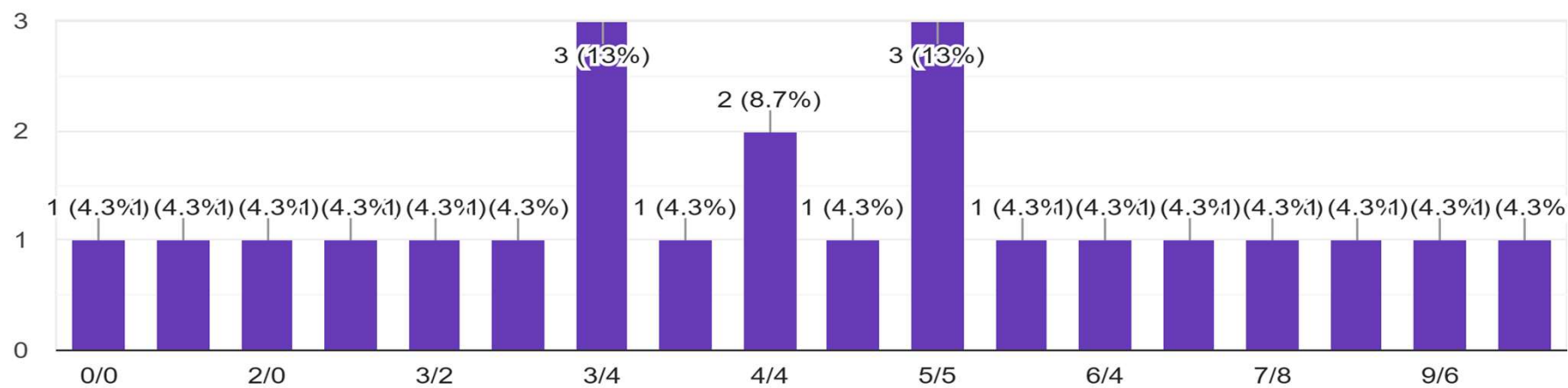

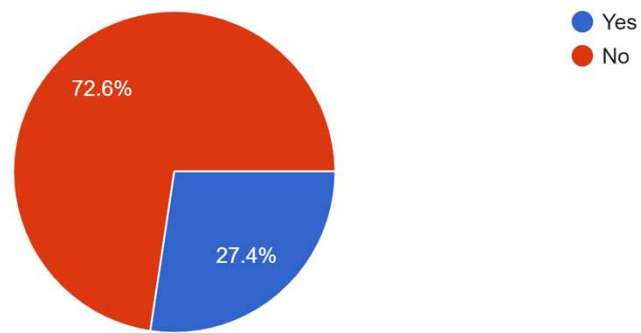

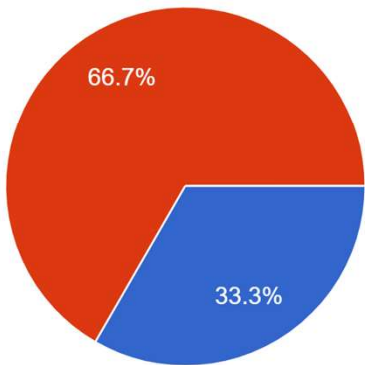

Digestive sensitivities - SIBO

Arthritis, pancreatitis and prone to urine infections, all coming with old age.

Aged 8 to 9 years repeated urine infections - scanned and found to have an enlarged and ulcerated prostate, so was castrated aged 9 and no further problems.

In old age (13/14 approximately) developed Pancreatitis. Various episodes up until she died aged 15.5. Prevented serious episodes by low fat diet.
